

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (RESTRICTED ROADS)  
(NEWINGTON PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 1999 20\*\***

The Oxfordshire County Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to that Act hereby make the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Newington Parish) Order 1999 and shall come into force on 26 November 1999.
2. The roads specified in the Schedule to this Order shall no longer be restricted roads for the purposes of section 81 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
4. No speed limit imposed by this Order applies to a vehicle falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011, being a vehicle used for naval, military or air force purposes, when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those regulations.
5. The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Newington Parish) Order 1999 is hereby revoked/replaced.

b)	Holcombe Lane	from its junction with A329, north-eastwards	for distance of 211 metres
