

**OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL
(NEWINGTON PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20****

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order - in support of road safety issues - is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Newington replacing the existing 30mph speed limit in the process as follows:

1. A329 Thame Road – from a point 156 metres northwest of its junction with Holcome Lane, southwards for a distance of 702 metres,
2. Holcombe Lane – from its junction with A329, north-eastwards for distance of 211 metres.

The existing 50mph speed limit on the A329 leading southwards from the village will remain in place, with Officers having taken the current road environment & traffic usage into account.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Restricted Roads) (Newington Parish) Order 1999 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
